PATIENT:

PRE-ANESTHESIA AND PRE-SURGICAL INSTRUCTIONS

FASTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not give any food after midnight the night before anesthesia
- Water should remain available at all times

SURGERY/ANESTHESIA CHECK-IN

- Bring your pet to the clinic at 8:30am the morning of the procedure.
- Plan to stay at the clinic 15-20 minutes unless other arrangements were made.
- If you have not completed the necessary consent forms, you will need to do so at the time of check-in.

GETTING AN UPDATE

- Exactly when your pet's procedure is performed will depend on several factors including completion of preoperative testing, pre-operative medication administration, and the other scheduled surgical procedures.
- Procedures are done in the order dictated by medical necessity and appropriateness.
- Most (not all) anesthetic/surgical procedures are completed and the patients are in recovery by 3pm. You are welcome to call anytime, but we may not have information about recovery until the afternoon.

WHEN WILL MY PET BE READY TO GO HOME?

- **NEUTERS AND SPAYS:** Cat neuters, dog neuters, and dog spays typically go home around 5pm the same day. Cat spays usually spend the night because they are more groggy.
- **CAT DECLAW:** Your cat will stay with us two nights and can go home on the third day. For example: if surgery is Monday morning, your cat will be ready to go home Wednesday during normal business hours.
- **TEETH CLEANING AND ORAL SURGERY**: In most cases, your pet will be ready to go home after 5pm on the same day as the procedure.
- **OTHER SURGICAL or ANESTHESIA PROCEDURES:** Depending on the procedure being performed, your pet may go home the same day or may need to stay one night or more.
